- ❖ Hyku is a turn-key, pre-generated Samvera application built using Hyrax, with many default choices already in place.
- ❖ The result of the IMLS grant-funded Hydra-in-a-Box project, spearheaded by Stanford University, the DPLA, and DuraSpace.

- ❖ Ubiquity Press + British Library
 - ❖ Shared repositories for British Library, British Museum, Tate Galleries, et al.
- ❖ CoSector w/ University of London + King's Fund Digital Archive
 - ❖ IIF and Universal Viewer support contributions

- ❖ Notch8 + NYC Dept. of Records and Information Services (DORIS)
 - ❖ Bug fixes & improved single-tenant version
- ❖ Notch8 + PALNI/PALCI
 - ❖ Additional theme customization
 - ❖ Improved user management

 - ❖ Create the ability for bulk content ingest through an automated process
- ❖ **Expansion of Work Types**
 - ❖ Expanding number of available work types and custom view ability per tenant
