#### What's Happened Since Last Year?

Releases since SamConn 2017:

- 2.0 November 2017
  - Major Dashboard Overhaul
  - Embargo & Lease management
  - Translations
  - Improved Controlled Vocabulary Support
- 2.1 May 2018
  - Collection Extensions
  - IIIF/Universal Viewer
- 11 subsequent releases since July 1
  - Currently at 2.3.3

#### What's Happened Since Last Year?

Accessibility

- Accessibility 360 Audit
- 110 audit related issues
- Hyrax 2.3 resolved ~ 70% of these
- Consideration: how do we ensure ally moving forward?

#### What's Happened Since Last Year?

Commitment to Stability

- Semantic Versioning
- Maintenance Policy
  - Moving forward maintain current and past major release series
  - Currently maintaining Hyrax 1.x and 2.x (and 2.0.x).
  - Backport of Security Issues
- Release Process
  - More frequent, smaller releases
  - QA as part of process
  - There are still improvements to make:
    - Accessibility
    - Documentation

### **Hyrax Working Group**

The Hyrax Working Group is charged with supporting core maintenance and development for Hyrax in order to provide a stable base of support for the solution bundle. This working group is not meant to be a replacement for community-led **development efforts** and/or contributions, but rather, it is meant to augment such efforts and release community members who are not part of the working group from the responsibilities around maintenance of Hyrax.

### **Hyrax Working Group**

- Resourced as an Agile team
  - Hyrax Product Owner
  - Hyrax Technical Lead
  - Facilitator/Project Manager
  - QA Specialist
  - Backend/Full Stack Developer (3)
  - UI/UX Developer (1)
- Running two week sprints
- Recharter for 6 months in January 2019
