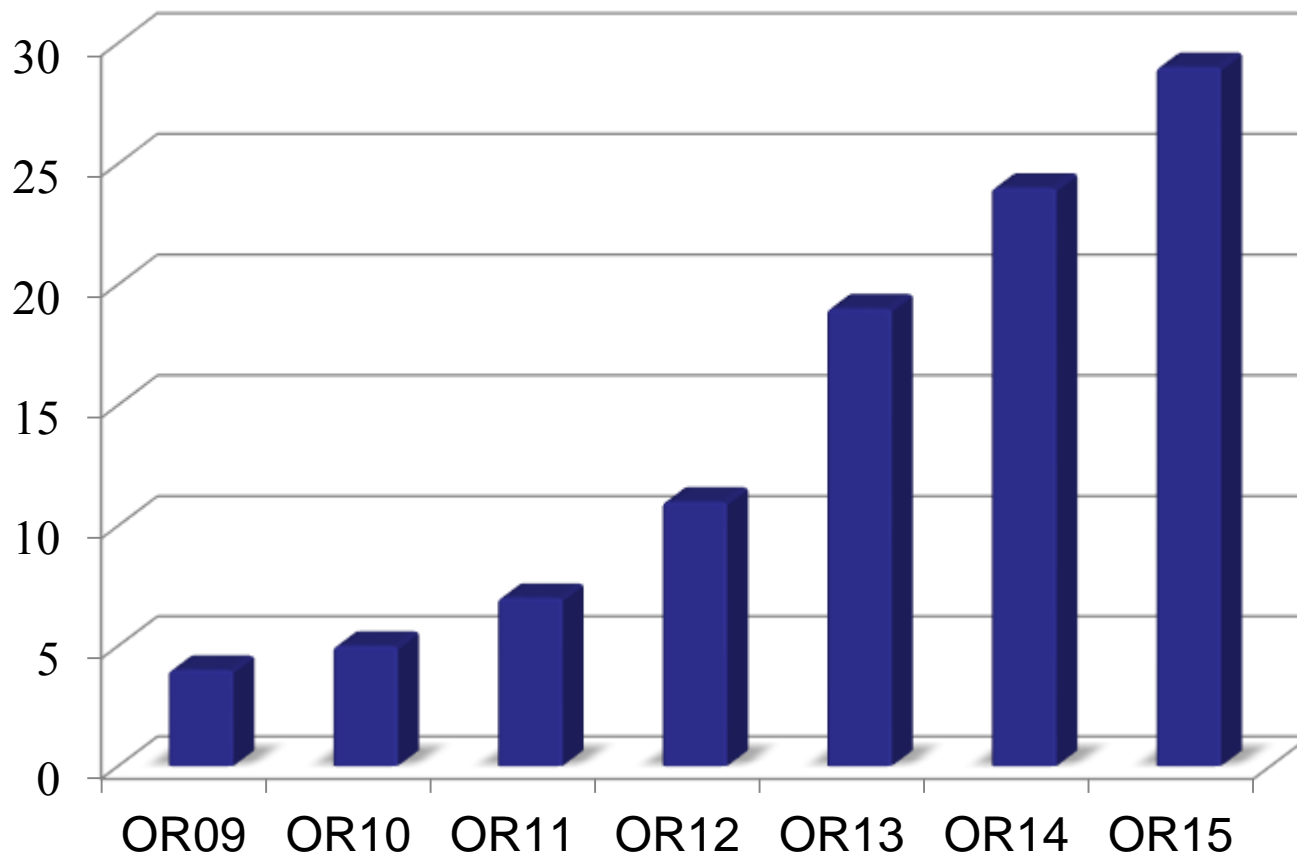

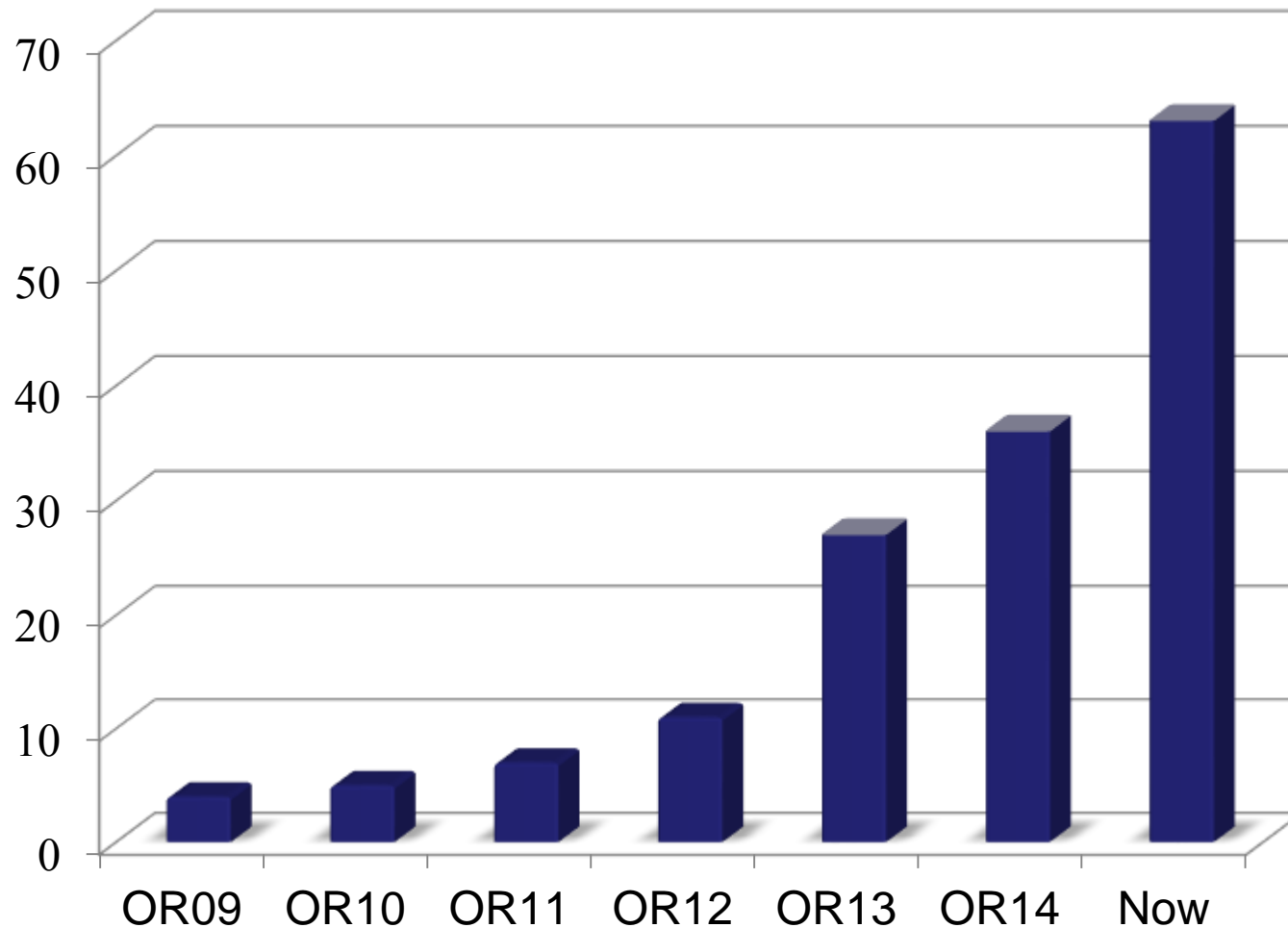

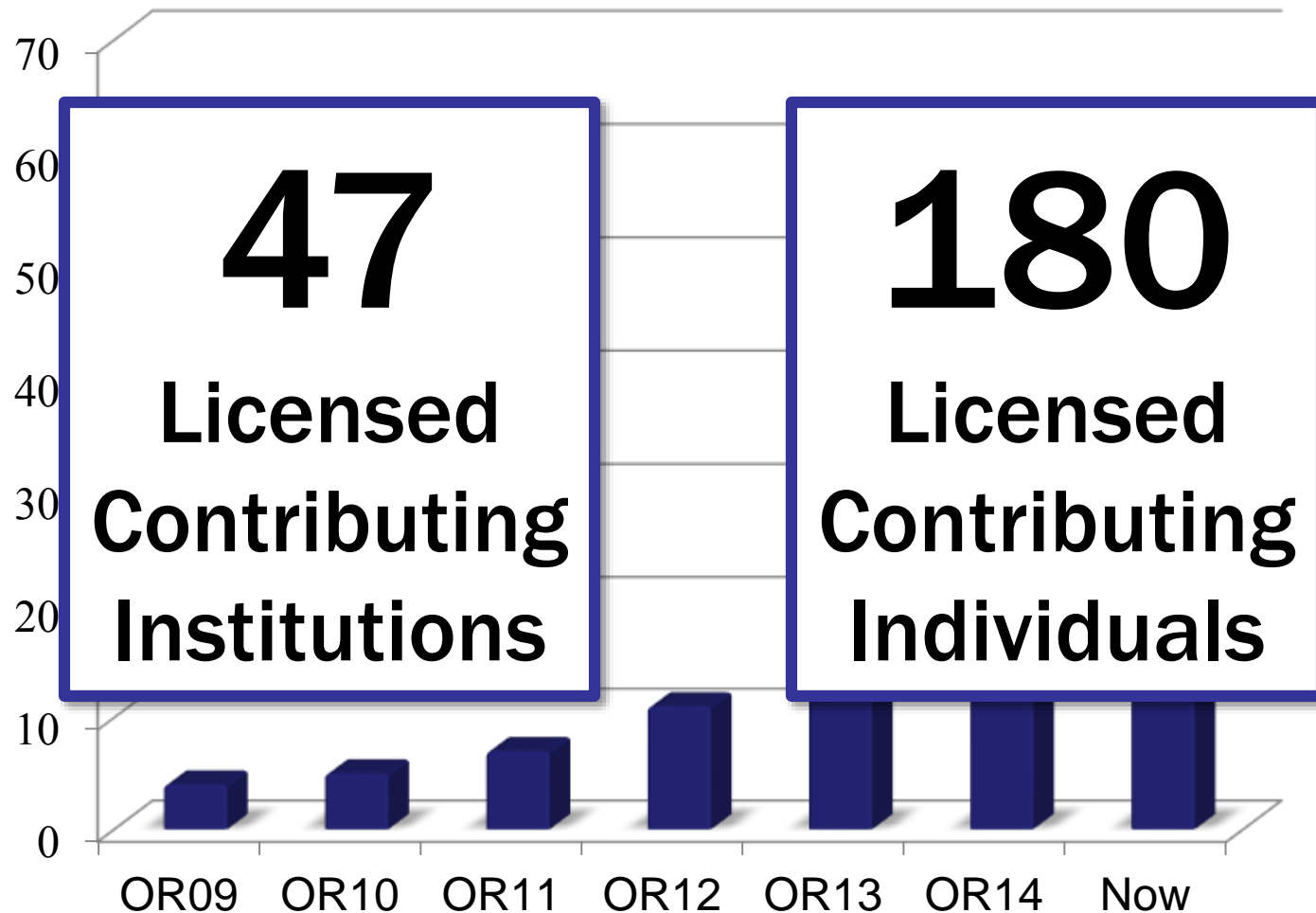

In a Nutshell, Project Hydra...

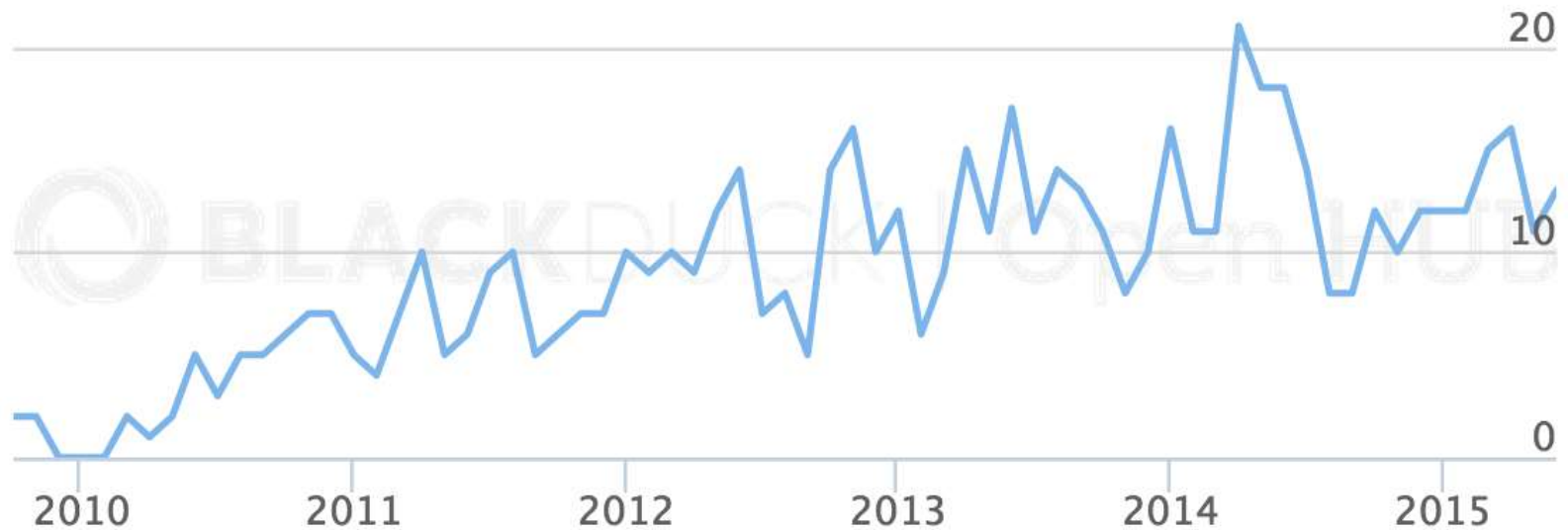
... has had **11,431 commits** made by **96 contributors** representing **71,560 lines of code**

... has **a well established, mature codebase** maintained by **a very large development team** with **stable Y-O-Y commits**

Sufia

In a Nutshell, sufia...

... has had **3,381 commits** made by **47 contributors**
representing **33,702 lines of code**

... took an estimated **8 years of effort** (COCOMO model)
starting with its **first commit in November, 2011**
ending with its **most recent commit about 2 months** ago

- **May 2015: 24 contributors from 12 institutions, one 2 week sprint**
- **Summer: 12 people for a sustained 9 week sprint**
- **Sufia now default starting point for adoption – more than 38 implementations in prod or dev in HydraSphere**
